The Ibiza lounge chair was designed to furnish the summer house of Germán Rodríguez Arias, architect and rationalism master, who was chosen by writer Pablo Neruda for the remodelling of his home in Isla Negra. Rodríguez Arias was a founder of GATCPAC, and consequently a partner of Torres Clavé, Sert, Illescas and other instigators of the Modern Movement in Spain. The lounge chair design features a single piece of steel tubing that affords a generous seat and deep backrest, conducive to great conversation. This extremely comfortable chair will incorporate the perfect pop of colour to any space. Upholstered in high quality Gabriel fabric.

General description:

Chrome-plated steel tube structure.
Seat and back upholstered and sewn by hand.

Two upholstery options: customer's choice of fabric and Gabriel's fabric from its samplers.
Plain fabric measures: 1,40 m / 55.1" long (70 cm / 27.5" seat and 70 cm / 27.5" back) and 1,40 m / 55.1" wide.

Maintenance:

Wipe clean with a soft cloth dampened with water. Do not use ammonia, solvents or abrasive cleaning products as these could damage the surface.
